Private individuals, firms, and educational institutions undertaking specific research and development projects; and Private foundations which do not qualify for certification under Item 6.1 of the guidelines (DOST A.O. 015 S. 2021)

HOW TO AVAIL THE SERVICE

CERTIFICATION OF PRIVATE FOUNDATIONS

REQUIREMENTS:

- Letter of intent to apply as a DOST-certified science foundation addressed to the Department Secretary
- A certified true copy: (a) Articles of Incorporation;
 (b) By-laws; (c) Certificate of registration of AOI
 & BL from SEC
- Scientific and Technological Activities (STA)
 program with a proposed budget for a period of
 three (3) years
- A list of officers and working staff
- A certification by the Treasurer of the foundation that it has an initial capital of at least one million pesos
- Notarized oath/affidavit for the application for certification (STFU 0015 Form)

CERTIFICATION OF SPECIFIC RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

REQUIREMENTS:

- Letter of intent to apply for certification addressed to the Department Secretary
- Specific research and development program accompanied by a detailed project study in DOST-prescribed forms with a proposed budget
- Notarized oath/affidavit for the application for certification (STFU 0016 Form)

CERTIFICATION FEES

REGISTRATION FEE FOR CERTIFIED FOUNDATIONS AND SPECIFIC R&D PROJECTS: Php 500.00

ANNUAL SERVICE FEE FOR CERTIFIED FOUNDATIONS: 0.12 of the 1% of the foundation's annual gross receipts

LIFE OF THE CERTIFICATION

FOR CERTIFIED PRIVATE FOUNDATIONS

The certification for private foundations issued under these rules shall be effective not earlier than the date of filing of the application and shall be in force for a period of not longer than three (3) years unless sooner revoked by DOST.

FOR SPECIFIC R&D PROJECTS

The certification for specific R&D projects shall be effective not earlier than the filing of the application and shall be in force until the completion of the project unless sooner revoked.
